His home is an easy 36-mile commute and Charlie believes that legislators are being dishonest if they own a residence within commuting distance and still collect per diem for a hotel room.

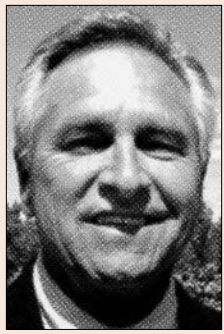
Jim Nielsen

Nielsen is originally from the San Joaquin Valley and, in his own statements to the newspapers in 2008, admitted that he has lived in Woodland (outside Assembly District 2) since 1969.

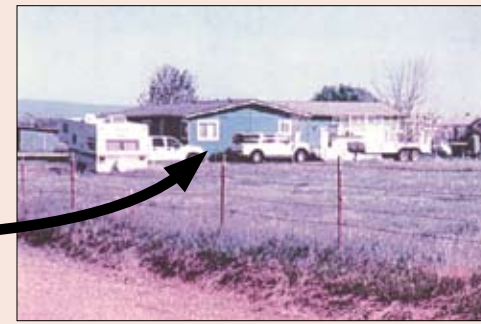
Nielsen owns a small ranch in the San Joaquin Valley but for the past quarter-century has made his living as an elected official or government appointee.

Nielsen has no record of ever serving in the military even though he grew up in the 1960s, during the Vietnam War.

Nielsen owns a \$900,000 home in a gated Woodland community outside Assembly District 2 and only 27 miles from the Capitol. But since this Woodland residence is outside the district he claims it is only a temporary home. He wants voters to believe that a double-wide trailer he purchased in Gerber from his in-laws is his home. Nielsen has collected more than \$49,000 in tax-free per diem since his election.

But he also owns this \$900,000 home in Woodland, just 27 miles from the Capitol—and not in District 2.

Jim Nielsen has collected \$49,804.52* in tax-free per diem** income from taxpayers to pay for lodging when the Assembly is in session.

Nielsen says it's just his "temporary" home. Right.

The California Secretary of State's Election Fraud Investigation Unit looked into it and referred the case to the Attorney General "for prosecution." But it's all about *who you know* and the Tehama County District Attorney (who failed to investigate the issue in Tehama County, where Nielsen filed legal documents to run for office) dropped it like the political hot potato it is. How many more times do we need to be told by our legal system that breaking the law is permitted if you're in politics???

* Since taking office in December 2008 through April 10, 2010.

** Per diem is provided at \$141/day for legislators to get a hotel or temporary quarters in Sacramento while in session. The funds are not to pay for a commute between their domicile/home and the Capitol.
